Planning ahead of your burial will bring immediate peace of mind and financial security to you and those you love.

One of the greatest gifts you can give them is the freedom of beautiful memories over mournful reality. Making cemetery arrangements well in advance of need is a family matter. It is, after all, the family who will be impacted both emotionally and financially by a death.

The biggest hurdle is getting the family to plan together. Your children are no doubt anxious for reassurance from you that everything has been taken care of, but they are understandably timid about approaching you about this sensitive matter.

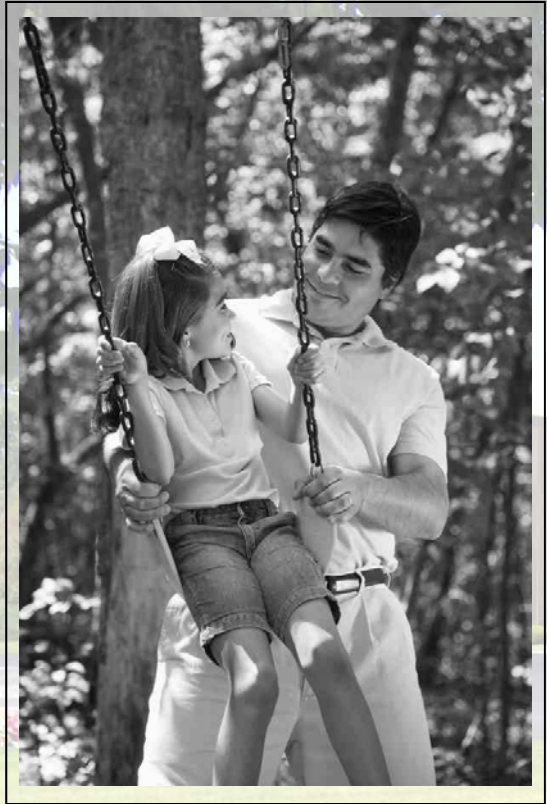
Providing leadership by speaking frankly to your family about the importance of preplanning is the best path to success.

The initial decisions in preplanning are so personal; they can only be made by you. What kind of memorial do you wish to prepare? Choosing a beautiful and well-managed cemetery that's close to family is paramount. It is also important to ensure that the cemetery offer options that coincide with your wishes. For example, if you desire an upright headstone, you should inquire if this is permitted.



After selecting the cemetery you desire, you must decide on the method of burial. Traditionally, the most common is in-ground burial but the number of families choosing above-ground options is increasing dramatically. When visiting a cemetery, you will want to discuss the burial options available with a cemetery representative. Some offerings are much less expensive than most people imagine, such as mausoleum entombment.

Memorialization is also an important step in remembering the life of a loved one. A memorial helps preserve those precious memories forever.



A Planned Investment. An emotionally distressed family often pays dearly for at-need arrangements that far exceed the wishes of the departed. Making your cemetery plans and paying for them well in advance will relieve your family of this burden, expense, and endless hours worrying and possibly conflicting with other family members about your burial wishes and whether they are met.

There is much to do, but plenty of time. People are taking responsibility early for preplanning. The generation of the early 1950s led the way by purchasing cemetery plots in advance of need. Their children, now in their 40s and 50s, are following suit by choosing and making complete burial plans as part of their estate planning.

There are well over fifty individual responsibilities to be completed by *someone* at the time of need. In a single meeting with one of our family service representatives, you can get one-third of these tasks accomplished.

BURIAL OFFERINGS FOR THE FULL BODY

◆ IN-GROUND BURIAL

The in-ground burial options include large family estate lots, multiple space lots, and single grave spaces. The space, depending on the size and location in the cemetery, can be memorialized with magnificent upright custom monuments to elegant flush memorials personalized with meaningful family and religious symbols that can be further enhanced with bronze plaques, statuary, vases, and other distinctive alternatives to the basic designs.

◆ MAUSOLEUM ENTOMBMENT

A structure or building containing crypts specifically designed for the entombment of casketed remains. A casket is placed in a crypt within a mausoleum when it is entombed.



⇒ PRIVATE ESTATE MAUSOLEUM

Distinctively designed personal mausoleums provide exclusive above-ground entombment.

The mausoleum can be personalized by adding options such as: Urns, vases, wings and numerous other enhancements. Meaningful family and religious symbols, artistically inscribed by experienced craftsmen, make the beautiful granite mausoleum an individualized testament to a life. The mausoleum provides private, permanent security and protection from the elements. The number of entombments within the private estate mausoleum varies on the size constructed.

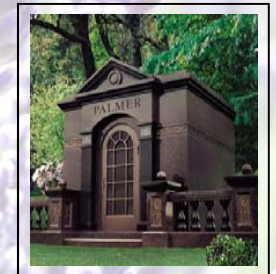

⇒ COMMUNAL MAUSOLEUM

Impressive mausoleum buildings offer individual elegant crypt space for the entombment of casketed remains. These crypts are a tribute attesting to the honor and dignity of a life lived. We offer both interior and exterior communal mausoleum crypts.

Cremation also requires a plan. It does not eliminate the need for a formal funeral, a necessary part of the grieving process for your family and friends, nor does it eliminate the need for a final resting place.

For members of the Catholic Faith the cremated remains of a body should be treated with the same respect given to the corporal remains. This includes the use of a worthy vessel for the cremated remains, the manner in which they are carried, the care and attention to appropriate placement and transport, and the final disposition. It is recommended that cremation take place after the funeral liturgy, however, the funeral liturgy may be celebrated in the presence of the cremated remains. Cremated remains of the body should be buried in a grave, entombed in a mausoleum, or inurned in a columbarium. Scattering of the cremated remains of the body is not permitted by the Catholic beliefs.

◆ CREMATION GARDEN

Typically, cremation gardens are specifically designed and beautifully landscaped areas in a natural setting and accommodates various expressions of memorialization. At the Catholic Cemeteries of the Diocese of Joliet, the garden provides a sanctuary for family members to honor a loved one with a memorial that features beautiful and innovative designs ranging from cored boulders, cored benches; developed with stunning statuary, pillars and bronze on granite flush memorials. A Cremation Columbarium is a structure, room, or other space in a indoor mausoleum or an outdoor environment, or other building containing niches. The columbarium niche space is available in various size capacities and provides a dignified and permanent housing enclosure for the cremated remains of the body.

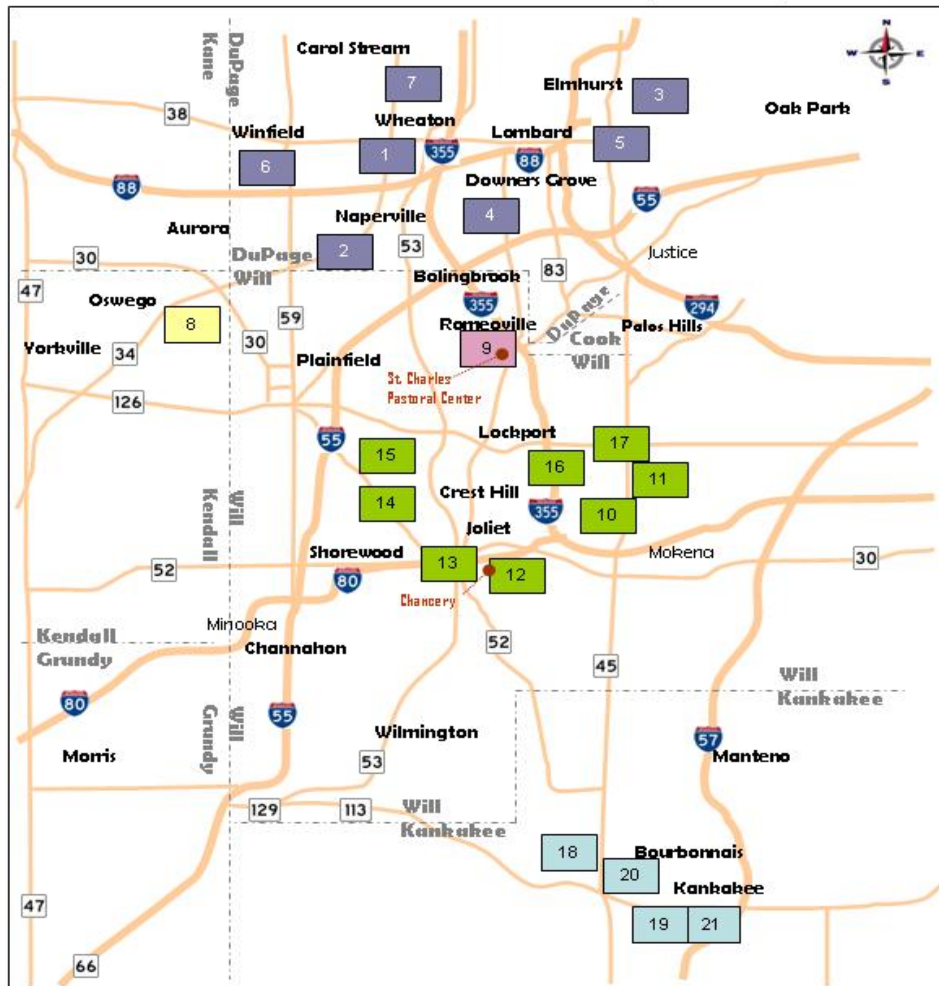

Overview of Cemetery Locations



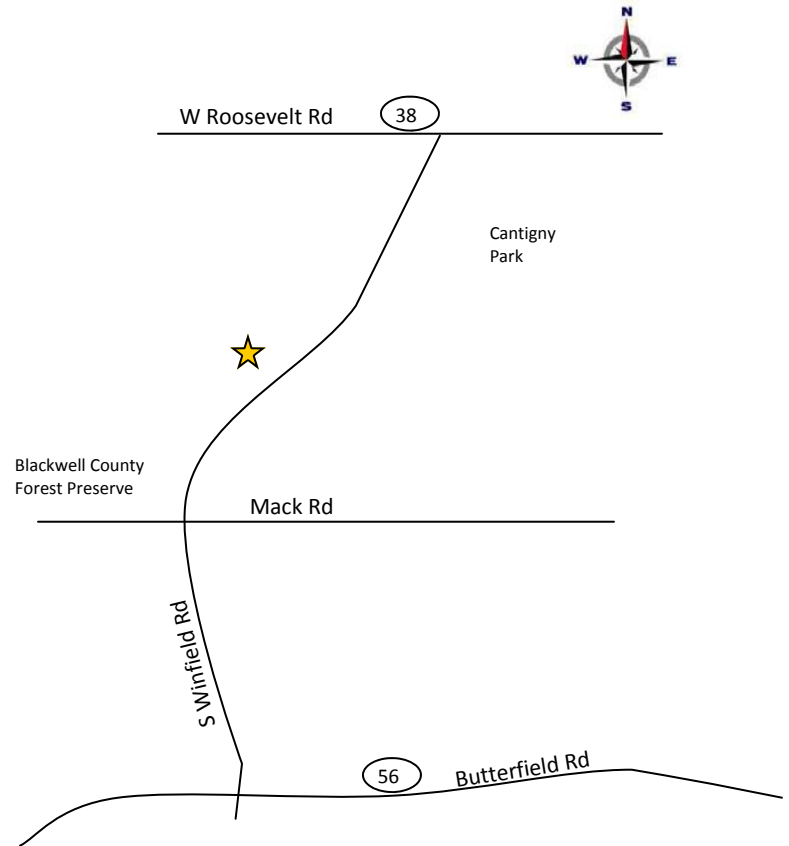
