September-December 2010

- ❖ Begin reading about the upcoming revision of the *Roman Missal* (USCCB.org website has much information and materials that can be purchased—materials for priests and the laity).
- ❖ The USCCB has bulletin articles on the parts of the Mass, role of ministers, role of the assembly <http://usccb.org/romanmissal/resources-bulletins.shtml> (copies are available for viewing at the Office of Divine Worship).
- ❖ The FDLC also has bulletin articles on the changes in each of the parts of the Mass—use the USCCB website address and look under Parish Resources—FDLC Resources (copies are available for viewing at the Office of Divine Worship).
  
- ❖ December 2, 2010 - Presentation for ADULT FAITH FORMATION LEADERS “Liturgical Spirituality” facilitated by Reverend Richard Fragomini (Sponsored by the Religious Education Office)

January-February 2011

- ❖ Begin the formation of PARISH LEADERSHIP through offering Evenings of Reflection or presentations on the Eucharist. Continue the “Year of the Eucharist” theme through these evenings and/or with study groups looking at the liturgical documents (Office of Divine Worship can assist with some materials).

March-May 2011

- ❖ March 14 - Institute for PRIESTS with Reverend Douglas Martis and The Liturgical Institute of the University of St. Mary of the Lake Mundelein
  
- ❖ March 15 - Institute for DEACONS AND PARISH PROFESSIONAL STAFF with Reverend Douglas Martis and The Liturgical Institute of the University of St. Mary of the Lake Mundelein

- ❖ March 24 - Institute for PARISH MUSIC DIRECTORS with Mr. Charles Gardner from the Archdiocese of Indianapolis on the new Chants, new setting for the Ordinary of the Mass and implications of new music norms. (Sponsored by the Office of Divine Worship)
- ❖ March 24 - Meeting for DIOCESAN YOUTH MINISTERS will discuss the new translation and provide guidance on how to introduce the changes to high school youth
- ❖ April 7 – DIOCESAN YOUNG ADULT MINISTRY GATHERING “Young Adults and the New Missal Translation” (recognizing that for those under 40, the current translation is the only translation of the Mass they know). Facilitator to be scheduled.
- ❖ April 9 - Institute for LITURGICAL/CATECHETICAL VOLUNTEERS AND TEACHERS with Reverend Douglas Martis and The Liturgical Institute of the University of St. Mary of the Lake Mundelein—presentation is at St. Martin of Tours Parish, Kankakee.
- ❖ May 14 - Institute for LITURGICAL/CATECHETICAL VOLUNTEERS AND TEACHERS with Reverend Douglas Martis and The Liturgical Institute of the University of St. Mary of the Lake Mundelein—presentation is at St. Scholastic Parish, Woodridge.
- ❖ The Catholic Schools Office will provide CATHOLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS with information and materials about the new translation for use with their students in the fall, including age appropriate explanations for the changes and materials they can use in teaching the students the revised texts of the Mass.
- ❖ The Youth Ministry Office will offer a workshop for VOLUNTEER YOUTH MINISTERS to assist them in introducing the changes to the young people of their parishes.

June-August 2011

- ❖ Throughout the summer Young Adult Ministry will host sessions of **THEOLOGY ON TAP** to explain and share the changes with YOUNG

ADULTS, COLLEGE STUDENTS, SINGLES, COUPLES and others who attend the presentations.

- ❖ June 24-26 – The **YOUTH LEADERSHIP CONFERENCE (YLC)** will have special sessions to prepare ADULT LEADERS, COLLEGE AGE, and TEENAGE participants for the new translation.
- ❖ August 11 Workshop for CATECHETICAL LEADERS on ‘Ground Level Implementation of the *Third Edition of the Roman Missal*’. This event is for those who work with children, youth and adults. After a keynote address, there will be breakout sessions for those working with specific ages and groups. (Sponsored by the Religious Education Office)
- ❖ CLUSTERS could host sessions for parishioners on the implementation of the *Third Edition of the Roman Missal*. The Office of Worship would assist with these sessions which would ‘open up’ the changes and discuss their affect on our worship life.

## September-November

- ❖ The OFFICE OF DIVINE WORSHIP will provide parishes with pew cards with the new translation of congregational responses as well as bulletin articles. The Office will also keep the priests and liturgy coordinators updated on other useful materials.
- ❖ If requested, Sister Sharon would be willing to go to parishes for presentations on the *Third Edition of the Roman Missal* and connect it with a renewal of our understanding of Eucharistic Theology.
- ❖ The DIOCESAN CAMPUS MINISTRY OFFICE will sponsor presentations on the college campuses on the topic “What’s Different at Mass” to discuss the new *Missal* translation.
- ❖ The YOUNG ADULT MINISTRY will offer workshops and sessions that will discuss what the new words and phrases mean.
