All those who have lost a spouse, either through death or divorce, as well as those who care for them, are warmly invited to join us on Saturday, March 28, for a day with Fr. Richard Gilbert.

Fr. Gilbert is an Anglican priest and author who has devoted his life to helping people through the stages of grief. As the Executive Director of the World Pastoral Care Center, Fr. Gilbert has spoken throughout the United States and internationally. He has a Ph.D. in Pastoral Psychology, is a Fellow of The American Association of Grief Counselors, and is an advisor to the National Catholic Ministry to the Bereaved. Fr. Gilbert's background in spirituality, grief counseling, and even his work with people suffering from post-traumatic stress disorder, will all be employed in his presentations.



On March 28, Fr. Gilbert will help us come to a greater awareness that the death of a relationship is the death of a dream. Our "sense of self" is deeply shaken, but, with the help of the God who loves us forever, we can be transformed through loss to become a new creation. No matter where you are in becoming this new creation, this day will help you appreciate and acknowledge the gains you have made and will offer wisdom and a new direction.

The day starts with a 9:00 a.m. check-in and concludes with a 4:00 p.m. liturgy, celebrated by Bishop Sartain, that satisfies the Sunday obligation. SPECIAL PRESENTATION FOR COUPLES ON MARCH 21

Open Hearts: Strengthening Your Marriage through Communication and Forgiveness

Dr. Everett Worthington, Jr., will address couples at a special conference on March 21 from 9 a.m. to noon. It will be held at the new Wentz Concert Hall at North Central College, 171 E. Chicago Avenue in Naperville.

Dr. Worthington is an internationally recognized authority and researcher on marriage and the psychology of forgiveness. A speaker in wide demand, he is the author of numerous publications and the author of a dozen books, including the book, *Forgiving and Reconciling: Bridges to Wholeness And Hope*. He is the founding editor of *Marriage and Family: A Christian Journal*, and is credited with helping to make forgiveness a legitimate and empirically-based part of marriage counseling.



The event is sponsored by the Inter-Parish Marriage Enrichment Team (IMET), a consortium of Catholic parishes in DuPage County who have banded together to offer high quality marriage enrichment opportunities for the community. Last year's conference with Dr. Brent Atkinson attracted over 200 couples to the day.

ANNULMENT FIELD ADVOCATE TRAINING Saturday, June 6

Quite often, a person investigating the possibility of an annulment has a difficult time beginning the process. Those who help the person at a parish normally become the field advocate for that person's annulment investigation. This training, co-sponsored by the Center for Family Ministry and the Joliet Diocesan Tribunal, will provide potential field advocates and existing field advocates with pertinent information about the annulment process. It will also offer practical ways for the field advocate to assist, coach, and be spiritually supportive with the annulment petitioners.

Those who come to this training are selected and sent by their parish staff and, in turn, will serve their own parish in this ministry. The training takes place at St. Charles Pastoral Center in Romeoville, from 8:30 a.m. (check-in begins at 8:00) to 3:00 p.m. and will be conducted by Father Joseph Tapella and Desirée Marciani. The \$15 fee covers continental breakfast, lunch and materials.

Although the training is not mandatory, it will be very helpful, both for existing field advocates, and those who want to begin to reach out to annulment petitioners. For registration information, concerns, or questions, call Desirée Marciani at 815-838-5334.

SUPPORT FOR ANNULMENT PETITIONERS

Working on annulment papers alone without support can be emotionally painful, overwhelming, and frustrating. Papers often get shoved into a desk drawer and more often than not are never worked on again. In an effort to help petitioners complete the process, the Center for Family Ministry, in collaboration with the Joliet Diocesan Tribunal, is once again offering a Day of Support and Reflection for Annulment Petitioners on Saturday, February 21, 2009 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. at the St. Charles Pastoral Center.

This workshop is designed for divorced persons who have petitioned the Diocesan Marriage Tribunal to begin the annulment process, have submitted basic data for introduction of their case, but have not yet completed the long questionnaire. Catholics and non-Catholics are welcome to attend, whether remarried or not.

The day will include time for prayer, time for questions, and input regarding annulments and the relational issues dealt with in the questionnaire. Participants will begin or continue filling out the questionnaire within a supportive environment. A team of pastoral ministers will be available for private consultation.
