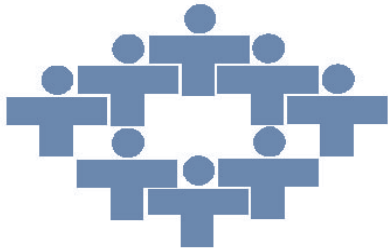

## “Welcome Your Child” Baptismal Program

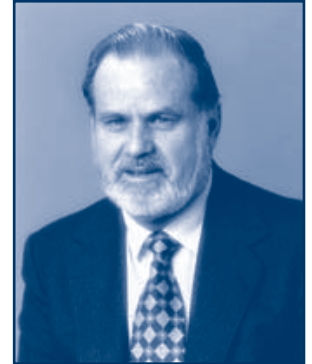

## A CONFERENCE FOR THE DIVORCED AND WIDOWED APRIL 9, 2011

### **BREAD BROKEN BUT MULTIPLIED**

Losing a spouse through death or because of a marriage break-up can be an earth-shattering experience. Like it or not, one experiences a period of personal “dying,” but hopefully, in time, a time of personal “rising”. No one understands dying and rising better than our Lord, Jesus Christ. In the Eucharist we relive the dying and rising of Jesus and join our suffering and rising to His.

Our diocese is in the midst of celebrating The Year of the Eucharist. This conference, **Bread Broken But Multiplied**, features **Brother Loughlan Sofield S.T.**, an internationally renowned retreat and group leader. His talks will weave together the Eucharistic experience with our journey through transition and loss and will also include a sensitive reflection on forgiveness. The Eucharistic journey invites us not only into the mystery of suffering but also into the peaceful, healing embrace of God. We are then sent forth to care for others and, in doing so, we continue our own healing.



Brother Loughlan is the Senior Editor of **Human Development** magazine, and the co-author and author of many books including **Design for Wholeness** and **Facing Forgiveness**. He has received worldwide recognition for his work with leaders of all ministries, including ministry to the divorced and the widowed. Known for his deep understanding of the human condition, he is able to bring people together and help them to come to a more hopeful understanding of their life's journey.

## JOYFUL AGAIN! A Widowed Ministry

**JOYFUL AGAIN!** is a two-day program for widows and widowers who want to resolve the grief they feel inside and begin to live again after the death of their spouse. The weekend employs a series of video presentations, followed by facilitated small group discussion and private reflection time. Through this process, individuals gain new insights and receive encouragement and support. Trained facilitators, who have been widowed themselves, help with the weekend and the discussions.

## ANNULMENT FIELD ADVOCATE TRAINING Saturday, March 19

Quite often, a person investigating the possibility of an annulment has a difficult time beginning the process. Those who help the person at a parish normally become the field advocate for that person's annulment investigation. This training, co-sponsored by the Center for Family Ministry and the Joliet Diocesan Tribunal, will provide potential "field advocates" and existing field advocates with pertinent information about the annulment process. It will also offer practical ways for the field advocate to assist, coach, and be spiritually supportive with the annulment petitioners.

**Those who come to this training are selected and sent by their parish staff and, in turn, will serve their own parish** in this ministry. The training takes place at St. Charles Pastoral Center in Romeoville, **from 8:30 a.m. (check-in begins at 8:00) to 3:00 p.m.** and will be conducted by Father Joseph Tapella, and Desirée Marciani. The \$15 fee covers coffee, lunch and materials.

Although the training is not mandatory, it will be very helpful, both for existing field advocates, and those who want to begin to reach out to annulment petitioners. For registration information, concerns, or questions, call Desirée Marciani at **815-838-5334**.

### SUPPORT FOR ANNULMENT PETITIONERS

Working on annulment papers alone without support can be emotionally painful, overwhelming, and frustrating. Papers often get shoved into a desk drawer and more often than not are never worked on again. In an effort to help petitioners complete their part of the process, the Center for Family Ministry, in collaboration with the Joliet Diocesan Tribunal, is once again offering a Day of Support for Annulment Petitioners on Saturday, **February 26, 2011 from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m.** at the St. Charles Pastoral Center.

This workshop is designed for divorced persons who have petitioned the Diocesan Marriage Tribunal to begin the annulment process, have submitted basic data for introduction of their case, but have not yet completed the Marriage Summary Questionnaire. Catholics and non-Catholics are welcome to attend, whether remarried or not.

The day will include time for prayer, time for questions and input regarding annulments and the relational issues dealt with in the questionnaire. Participants will have time to begin or continue filling out the questionnaire within a supportive environment. Pastoral ministers will be available for private consultation.
