

Is Sexual Addiction A Problem?

This screening survey was developed through the testing of thousands of sexual addicts.

An answer of 'yes' to three or more of the following questions suggests that sexual addiction may be present.

YES NO Has there been a recurrent failure to resist sexual impulses in order to engage in a specific sexual behavior?

YES NO Have you frequently engaged in those behaviors to a greater extent or over longer periods of time than intended?

YES NO Have you made unsuccessful efforts to stop, reduce or control those behaviors?

YES NO Have you spent inordinate amounts of time obtaining sex, being sexual or recovering from sexual experiences?

YES NO Are you frequently preoccupied with sexual behavior or preparatory activity?

YES NO Have you frequently engaged in sexual behavior when expected to fulfill other obligations related to job, school, family or friends?

YES NO Have you continued a specific sexual behavior despite knowledge of risk to career, finances, health or relationships?

YES NO Have you needed increased intensity, frequency, or level of risk to achieve the desired effect from a sexual behavior?

YES NO Have you limited or missed social, recreational or occupational activities because of sexual behavior?

YES NO Have you experienced distress, anxiety, irritability or restlessness if unable to engage in a specific sexual behavior?

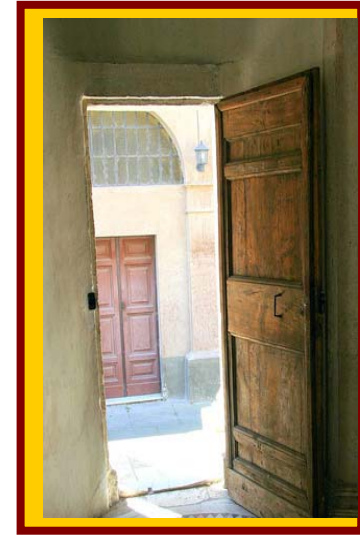
