- who would like to sign up as a “small group” (dependent on class size limitations)
- who, at the discretion of the CL, would benefit in “some way” by taking a course

Scholarship money can also be used for any required textbooks.

Requirement: All scholarship recipients will be asked to write a review of their experience that may be used in future diocesan materials.
