

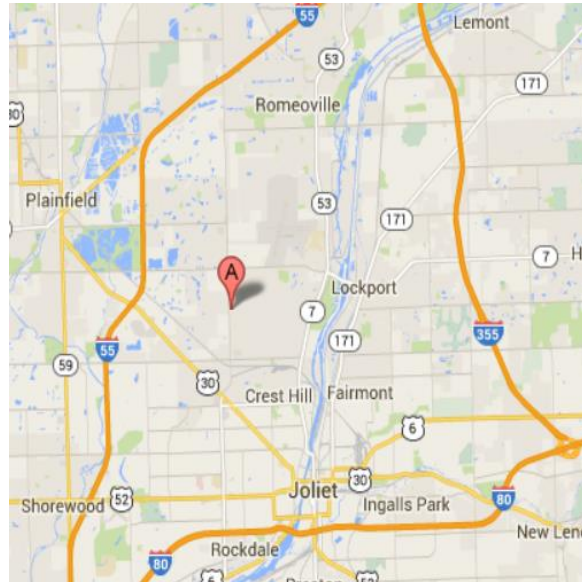

Driving Directions

Access from the major highways:

From the North: Take I-55 South. Exit 263 for Weber Rd. Go South through Romeoville. Take left onto Randich Road (left turn lane at light). Take first right into parking lot.

From the South: Take I-55 North. Exit 267 for Route 30. Take right on Rt 30. Take first left on to Essington Rd. At the “T”, turn right onto 16th St. This street turns into Division St. Follow Division St to Weber Rd. Turn left on Weber Rd. Turn right onto Randich Road (stop light). Take first right into parking lot.

From the West or East. Take I-80. Exit 130B to merge onto IL-7 N/ Larkin. Go north on Larkin Ave. Continue to follow Larkin Ave. which turns into Weber Road. Follow Weber Rd to Randich Rd (stop light). Turn right onto Randich Rd. Take the first right into parking lot.
