A & E BIOGRAPHY: MYSTERIES OF THE BIBLE: LAST SUPPER (Order Number: LLSL0128) VHS 4 Min. JSA 1996. In 5-10 Min. segments in 5 Acts, hosts Richard Killy and Jean Simmons narrate the scripture using art, actual visits to historical sites, visual enactments and hear from scholars, we can get an idea of the Journey to Jerusalem, Jesus' premonition of death, Passover/Sedar Meal, Betrayal, and Holy Communion.

ANGEL'S FIRST COMMUNION LESSON (Order Number: SREX0063) VHS Instructional. 13 Min. EM 1999. Angel Michaela and friends offer their heavenly aid to catechists and children. In simple, clear language the angels speak of Jesus' presence at Mass and the Eucharist. Topics include prayer, religion class, Mass and Scripture.

ANGEL'S MASS LESSON (Order Number: SREX0000) VHS Instructional. 13 Min. M 1996. Danny is angry that his parents insist that he attend Mass. With the help of the angel Veritas, Danny witnesses a second century Eucharistic celebration. Danny comes to understand the precious gift of the Eucharist, and what Liturgy can become.

ANIMATED STORIES FROM THE NEW TESTAMENT: #14) BREAD FROM HEAVEN CVSX0055 25 Min. EM 1995. In this recounting of the feeding of the 5,000, we meet Jonas, a street urchin who hears about a savior Jesus who offers to satisfy one's hunger forever, the One who is the Bread of Life.

BABETTE'S FEAST (Order Number: FFXX0019) DVD Drama. 102 Min. All G 1988. Danish and French with English subtitles. Screen version of a story by Isak Dinesen, set in a rugged Danish fishing village in 1871, shows the impact of a French housekeeper (Stephane Audran) on two pious sisters who carry on their late father's work as pastor of a dwindling religious flock. Conclusion follows the preparation and consumption of an exquisite French meal, with focus on its sensual and religious implications and its healing effect on the austere sect and the Frenchwoman who prepares it. Danish director Gabriel Axel's low-key and understated work is rich with detail and fine, controlled performances. Subtitles.

BEDBUG BIBLE GANG (*series name*) 3D computer animation with illustrations presented by the bedbugs, brings scripture alive for children. Using interactive games and popular children's nursery rhyme tunes to summarize what they learned.

MIRACLE MEALS - DVD (Order Number: CVSX0357) DVD 23 Min. E 2001. Elijah, the widow and endless jar. Last supper. Loaves and Fishes; each presented with song and games.

BEING CATHOLIC - CREED - DVD (Order Number: SRCX0073) DVD Instructional. 30 Min. JSA 2007. This program provides the fundamentals of our Catholic faith in four concise, engaging and informative segments. Based on Part 1 of Catechism of the Catholic Church, "What Catholics Believe." Being Catholic Part 1 will allow young people who have missed out on religious education opportunities to begin to "catch up" with their peers. Centering on the Creed, "Being Catholic" helps prepare for the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist, and to better participate in parish life. Aimed primarily at young persons, the information contained in this program could also be helpful in RCIC. Grades 5 and up, 4 segments - 10 min. each.

BROTHERS OF AMERICA (Order Number: MLXX0009) VHS Drama. 20 Min. MJSA 1980. The story of two boys both 12 years old is narrated by their pastor formerly stationed in a US parish but now a missionary in Bolivia. Both boys are treated with respect and the commonalities and differences of their two cultures, hopes and dreams are treated positively. Finally their lives are woven together through the Holy Childhood and both boys are shown joined together in the one Body of Christ through the Eucharist celebrated in each of the different cultures and countries.

CALLED TO SERVE: THE EUCHARISTIC MINISTER (Order Number: LLTX0000) VHS 30 Min. A 1991. This informative video offers up-to-date guidelines to prepare Eucharistic ministers for their role of service to the faith community. Video addresses practical concerns such as preparation for liturgy, entrance procession, readying the bowls

and cups for distribution, what to do if there is a spill. Highlights of historical and theological background of ministry are included, as well as a discussion of the pastoral practice and liturgical role of lay ministry.

CATACOMB (*series name*) Archbishop Philip M. Hannan and Mary Lou McCall provide a close-up personal tour and discussion on the devotional life, hierarchical structure, and the catacombs in general in the early church.

BREAD OF LIFE (Order Number: CHXX0001) VHS Documentary. 30 Min. JSA 1993.
DEVOTIONAL LIFE OF THE CHURCH IN THE EARLY CENTURIES - This video focuses on the spirituality of the oppressed beginning with an explanation of the Christian persecution. Sites such as the prison, the Coliseum, and the catacombs are presented. The roles of ministry as well as the Eucharist are the undertones of the video.

CATECHUMENATE, THE / WHAT ARE THE CHALLENGES PARISHES FACE? (Order Number: SRRX0006) VHS 30 Min 1991. This lecture by Rev. Fragomeni invites listeners to consider Baptism as death in Jesus Christ, sin in a social context, Eucharist as solitary subsistence, and mission /service as recognition of our giftedness as beings in Christ.

CATHOLIC MASS: YESTERDAY AND TODAY (Order Number: LLTX0034) VHS 45 Min. JS 2000

The video gives an over view of the Catholic Mass. It clarifies some of the rituals of mass as they are celebrated today, explains how the mass has changed, and uncovers the meaning the mass holds for those who celebrate it.

CATHOLIC UPDATE (*series name*) This resource series is designed for use in RCIA, catechist formation, sacramental programs for parents, faith-sharing groups and youth ministry. Each episode is composed of four segments: story, witness, teachings and music reflection. Some segments can stand alone.

EUCCHARIST: CELEBRATING CHRIST PRESENT (Order Number: SRGX0002) VHS Instructional. 30 Min. SA 1990. The importance of traditions and customs is conveyed through the story of a devoted grandmother and parish sacristan who through an accident, becomes incapacitated and is unable to fulfill her role as the one through whom the tradition is conveyed. The ritual celebrations of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday are presented briefly within the story line.

EXPERIENCE CHRIST PRESENT (Order Number: SRGX0073) Book. Program planner for Catholic Update Eucharist Series. Ties in the three videos for Eucharist.

FIRST COMMUNION: TAKING YOUR PLACE AT THE TABLE (Order Number: SRGX0003) VHS Instructional. 30 Min. SA 1990. Intended to help for parents preparing their children for first Eucharist. This story features Kimberly, who is about to make her First Communion. She cannot understand why her grandfather, who is grieving over his wife's death and his own forced retirement, is acting differently. She learns that coming to the Eucharist table means learning new responsibility for others. In the witness segment, parents share experience of their children's First Communion.

CATHOLIC UPDATE: CHURCH CELEBRATES: LENT AND EASTER – DVD LLSL0156 32 Min. 2003. Overview of the essence and order of the pivotal seasons of Lent and Easter in liturgy as a time of renewal and intense preparation for those who are to be baptized. Story segment: A man's personal story of spiritual death and resurrection illustrates the Paschal Mystery. 8 Min. Witness segment: Catholics talk about the meaning of Lent/Easter 3 Min. Teaching segment: Fr. Tom Richstatter overviews the Easter Season from Lent to Pentecost. 8 Min. Reflection: "Shelter Your Name" Danielle Rose 3 Min.

WALK THROUGH THE MASS, A (Order Number: SRGX0016) VHS Instructional. 31 Min. SA 1998. Explores the meaning behind the celebration of Eucharist and the four principal parts of Mass: Story segment: Bread that Remembers. Parable of two brothers who become estranged, and the wise woman who restores the goodness into the bread. 8 Min. Witness segment: real-life Catholics share the power of the Eucharist in their lives. 5 Min. Teaching segment: Fr. Tom Richstatter draws the parallel between the shape of the Mass and a typical Thanksgiving dinner; and the four parts of the Mass and rituals. 14 Min. Music video: "The Song of the Body of Christ" by David Haas: meditation on the Eucharist. 3 Min.

CELEBRATING OUR FAITH (*series name*)

EUCCHARIST: CHILDREN (Order Number: SREX0059) VHS Interactive. 37 Min. EM 1999.

This video helps children prepare for Eucharist. 1) 4 min. Through baptism we learn the importance of "us" 2) 4 min. Of all the foods, love is the best. 3) 3 min. Gathering for Eucharist, we need to include all in our hearts. 4) 4 min. The Scripture helps us know how to live. 5) 5 min. On the altar, God's love is revealed through Body and Blood. 6) 6 min. Teachers help us in preparing for 1st Eucharist. 7) 3 min. Kempf and Big Al discuss what it's like to receive Communion. 8) 8 min. Communion goes beyond the Mass.

EUCARIST: FAMILIES (Order Number: SREX0061) VHS Reflection. 52 Min. A 1999. The family is the "domestic church" where parents, by word and example are the first teachers of the Catholic faith. This video is for those helping prepare the children for Eucharist. Introduction: 4 min. Preparation for catechetical coordinators. 1) 18 min. Kempf reflects on how God feeds the deepest hungers of our hearts through the Eucharist. 2) 12 min. Kempf discusses the importance of the role of parents in the faith of their children and offers ways that they might help children prepare for Eucharist. 3) 9 min. Kempf reminds us that Eucharist is a lifelong sacrament, not a single event. 4) 9 min. In a moving prayer meditation, Kempf invites us to see the presence of God in daily events and in the Eucharist.

CELEBRATING SACRAMENTS (*series name*) This series is produced for parents whose children are preparing to receive baptism, reconciliation, Eucharist, or confirmation.

EUCARIST: CELEBRATING COMMUNITY (Order Number: SREX0049) VHS Instructional. 15 Min. A 1990. This video program has been produced for use with parents whose children are preparing to receive the Eucharist for the first time. It provides theological and scriptural background to help parents reflect upon their own understanding of the Eucharist and their role in their children's spiritual and religious development. **EUCARIST: CELEBRATING COMMUNITY: BOOK** (SREX0052)

CHANGING SACRAMENTS, THE (Order Number: SRGX0009) VHS Video strip. 118 Min. JSA 1973. A historical examination of the sacraments is presented in a whimsical yet thorough medium to be enjoyed by almost all ages. CHILDREN'S ADORATION (Order Number: SREX0081) VHS Instructional. 30 Min. JSA 2002. This video is dedicated to parents, catechists and priests who want to lead young children to discover the hidden and loving silent presence of Jesus in the Eucharist.

CHRISTOPHER'S: LET'S TALK ABOUT YOU (*series name*) This series develops spirituality for teens and pre-teens. It's meant to stimulate young people to thought and conversation about questions which touch them deeply.

#03) WHO IS JESUS CHRIST (Order Number: YMSX0070) VHS Interactive. 30 Min. JS. This video is all about Jesus and the love He engenders in his followers. Listen to the testimony of young and old about the Lord of their life. Jesus is presented not only as a man for others, but primarily as a man of the Father. Surrender to the Father's will is the central idea emphasized. Entertainment segments include Ray Repp singing a well-known song which he composed: "I am the Resurrection and The Life". A beautiful sequence of deaf and hard of hearing children who encircle a priest during the celebration of mass, pray with him in Sign Language. The Eucharist unites us to Christ in special ways. Video invites viewer to a deeper love of Jesus who is the "Bread of Life". David Hartmann of "Good Morning America" reciting "One Solitary Life." Two Cardinals, a black Bishop and a famous Jesuit priest giving their own personal testimony. Twelve lay people ranging from grandparents to very young teenagers also tell of their love of Jesus, and a twenty-year old woman who was losing her mind and her life to drugs until she discovered the key to real faith.

CHRISTOPHER'S: THE CHURCH ALIVE (*series name*)

CELEBRATING THE EUCARIST (Order Number: SREX0002) VHS Instructional. 30 Min. SA. A compact presentation of the theology, purpose, and history of the celebration of the Eucharist.

COME TOGETHER (Order Number: SREX0007) VHS Instructional. 90 Min. A 1986. An adult catechesis on the Eucharist. Components independent study, faith sharing, group study, video. Video presentation shows the theological principle as it is lived in human experience through moving skits. This is followed by a brief instruction on each element of the Liturgy. The content is rooted in the General Instruction of the Roman Missal. Session Topics: Celebration; Gathering; Power of spoken

word; Remembering; Sharing and Reconciliation; Call to Serve.

COMMUNICATING THROUGH MINISTRY (*series name*) Through our ministry we communicate Christ to those we serve. In each program fundamental communication skills are presented in light of Christian values.

#05) CELEBRATING (Order Number: CLXX0051) VHS Instructional. 20 Min. A 1988. The celebration of the sacraments is central to the expression of our faith. The purpose of this program is to help priests and others involved in the celebration understands how to convey the message of the sacraments most effectively. The style of the celebrant is central here, for the celebrant becomes the physical focus for the congregation. Emphasis in the program is given to the celebration of the Eucharist.

CONFIRMATION: FAITH ALIVE (Order Number: SRCX0004) VHS Video strip. 15 Min. S 1986. An effective program to use with teen Confirmation candidates, their parents and sponsors. Challenges and inspires youth to witness to the Gospel values of Jesus. It presents this sacrament for the students in terms of deepening the faith commitment made for them at Baptism and nurtured personally through the Eucharist.

CONFIRMING FAITH (*series name*) Sawyer takes the content of her sacramental text, "Confirming Faith", and presents a practical methodology to its implementation.

DESALES: OUR CELEBRATION OF THE EUCHARIST (*series name*) This series leads adults into a better appreciation of the impressive history and meaning of the Mass. Studies of the liturgy and spirituality of the Eucharist are explored. **PARTICIPANT MANUAL** (Order Number: SREX0016) Book. Participant Manual to video series.

SESSION 1 - 2 (Order Number: SREX0008) VHS Instructional. 60 Min. 1989. **SESSION 1: FROM PASSOVER TO EUCHARIST** - The Hebrew roots of Christian Eucharist are presented. Eucharist, themes in the Gospels and Pauline writings are discussed. **SESSION 2: OF RITUALS AND HUMAN ELEMENTS** - A historical tour of the development of the Mass explain the purpose of revisions by the Second Vatican Council.

SESSION 3 - 4 (Order Number: SREX0010) VHS VHS Instructional. 60 Min. 1989. **SESSION 3: A LOOK AT HOW CATHOLICS BEGIN THEIR WORSHIP TODAY** - This segment presents a step-by-step analysis of each part in the Introductory Rites to the Eucharist. **SESSION 4: CATHOLICS USE THE SCRIPTURES, TOO!** - A study of the Liturgy of the Word is coupled with a presentation of the "Theology of the Word."

SESSION 5 - 6 (Order Number: SREX0012) VHS VHS Instructional. 60 Min. 1989. **SESSION 5: BOTH ALTAR AND TABLE** - A reflection of the Liturgy of the Eucharist focuses on the mystery and spirituality of the Eucharist. **SESSION 6: WE BECOME LIVING BREAD** - Elements of the Communion Rite address options of reception, Eucharistic ministers, and obligation.

SESSION 7 - 8 (Order Number: SREX0014) VHS VHS Instructional. 60 Min. 1989. **SESSION 7: WHY IT'S DIFFERENT EVERY SUNDAY** - A reflection of "liturgical time" focus on holy days, creativity, and the liturgical seasons. **SESSION 8: WHERE DOES THE TABERNACLE AND BENEDICTION FIT TODAY?** - The history and evolution of Eucharistic devotion put into perspective the concepts of fasting, reception and spirituality.

DIVINE LITURGY OF ST. JOHN CHRYSOSTOM (Order Number: ECXX0012) VHS Instructional 50 Min. 1989. The liturgy of Eucharist celebrated according to the Byzantine Rite is shown and explained. Helpful to understand the liturgy of the Eastern Catholic Church.

EASTER SEASON (Order Number: LLSL0007) VHS Instructional 20 Min. 1990. Parents experience a "letting go" as their children grow into adulthood and begin a new life. But parents also learn that memories will hold a family together, despite moves or transitions; so family experience can teach us about the Eucharist, in which we remember Jesus' passion and death and celebrate his

new life in the Resurrection.

EASTER TRIDUUM (Order Number: LLSL0070) VHS 180 Min. 1998. Fr. John Corapi presents a workshop from EWTN TV on the profound spiritual significance of events during Holy Week. Three 60 min. segments of Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Holy Saturday. Enlightenment on the mystery of the Last Supper and the Paschal Sacrifice on Holy Thursday, and how we share in the Paschal Mystery of going to Mass and Holy Communion. Good Friday covers the meaning and mystery of suffering that takes on greater merit when joined with Christ on the cross. Holy Saturday, just as Jesus descended into hell, we descend into the pit and darkness in our lives to come into the light of resurrection.

ECHOES OF FAITH: CATHOLIC FAITH SERIES (*series name*) Echoes of Faith is a catechist formation program being developed by the National Conference of Catechetical Leadership in conjunction with RCL / Tabor. Rooted in the Catechism of the Catholic Church, this video is for catechists by catechists. Each video is closed captioned for the hearing impaired.

#02) LITURGY AND SACRAMENTS (Order Number: CLXX0088) VHS Instructional 60 Min. 1997. This module explores the meaning of liturgy and sacraments and gains weight into why the sacramental life of the faith community is central to Catholic identity. EUCHARIST A CELEBRATION OF LIFE (Order Number: SREX0018) VHS Reflection 9 Min. 1987. Through integrating images of nature, human experiences of rescue and inclusion with liturgical gestures and symbols, this video visually illustrates the presence of Christ in the Eucharist and well as the incarnational presence of Christ in every aspect of human life. This video attempts to explore the mystery of Eucharist through artistic expression.

EUCHARIST A TASTE OF GOD (Order Number: SREX0020) VHS Instructional 120 Min. 1993. Joe Kempf offers a refreshing look at Eucharist in a reflective and dynamic manner. This video is not meant to be watched in one sitting. Each section is 10 - 15 minutes and encourages discussion, prayer, and group activities.

EUCHARIST FOR LITTLE CHILDREN - DVD (Order Number: SREX0106) DVD Instructional 20 Min. 2007. Host Jennifer Naimo's boundless energy and love for the Eucharist will help young children understand and encounter Jesus in the mass. Jennifer teaches the children about the Church, the priests robes, and how the bread and wine for Eucharist are made, how to dress and act for Church.

EUCHARIST PARABLE (Order Number: SREX0019) VHS Drama 24 Min. 1989. Kate Clairbour, a writer, is divorced and the mother of a teenager daughter. When Kate is confronted with the reality of her hidden but terminal illness, she is inspired to invite her alienated brothers to a family Thanksgiving. At the table she shares how important the love and support of family are to her. Her openness allows the feelings of the two bothers to surface; first anger and hurt, followed by forgiveness and reconciliation. However, Kate herself is challenged to even greater forgiveness. Early Thanksgiving Day, Kate's daughter Christy had, unknown to her mother, discovered the doctor's report on Kate's illness. In an impulsive gesture Christy calls her divorced father, informing him of the situation and of the "family" dinner her mother is having.

EUCHARIST: GOD'S WAY OF EMBRACING US (Order Number: SREX0095) VHS Reflection 100 Min. 2005. Made in the year of the Eucharist, Fr. Rolheiser points out the importance of being a Eucharist people, Eucharistic church, a community formed and nurtured by the Eucharist. He shows how that works, the various meanings, the radically physical of long ago, transubstantiation-change what

you are. He uses humor, Jewish stories, biblical references and today's perspective.

EUCHARIST: SOURCE AND THE SUMMIT, THE (Order Number: SREX0093) VHS Reflection 26 Min. 2005. Part one - 9 Min. EXPLORING THE TEACHING OF CHRIST (*series name*) This basic program in adult faith formation provides a form of catechesis that Church documents so often defined as the central kind of adult formation in the Church. It seeks to be a complete balanced, well-rounded approach to the whole reality of Catholic truth and life. Presentation, discussion, and prayer.

#02) ST. TARCISIUS (Order Number: BISX0009) VHS Video strip. 10 Min. Tarcisus is a Christian boy who secretly communicates with Christian prisoners. In trying to smuggle the Eucharist to the condemned, Tarcisus is discovered as a Christian and condemned to death in the Coliseum.

FIRST COMMUNION: A FAMILY JOURNEY (Order Number: SREX0087) VHS Instructional 20 Min. 2003. Two parts: First Communicant: 10 min. Parent segment 10 min. Produced in cooperation with religious education specialists at Silver Burdette Ginn Religion Division this program provides separate segments for children and parents. The meaning of Eucharist, Baptism and membership into the Church is clear for both Communicants and their parents. Older traditional teachings.

FIRST EUCHARIST (Order Number: SREX0021) VHS Video strip 32 Min. 1983. This video strip instructs students on the sacrament of Eucharist. It is a basic introduction to the liturgical dimension.

FOCUS ON THE SACRAMENTS SERIES (*series name*) These videos are part of the catechist formation program sponsored by the Diocese of Boston. It consists of three lectures, each tape, directed at catechists and teachers of religion but appropriate for all adults. GOSPEL ACCORDING TO MATTHEW: VISUAL BIBLE (*series name*) The Gospel of Matthew is vividly presented in this four-volume set. Jesus is portrayed as human and divine in this epic biographical drama. This literal interpretation is ideal for study groups and classroom references.

VOLUME 4: MATTHEW 24:1-28:20 (Order Number: SBNX0117) VHS 64 Min. JSA 1996. As Jesus' ministry begins to reach its purpose, the conflict of the religious authorities deepens in this word-for-word account of Matthew's book. The final events present Matthew's perspective of the Last Supper, the Garden of Gethsemane, betrayal and denial, trial, and crucifixion of Jesus. The anguish of the cross is transformed by the glory of the resurrection.

GREATEST STORY EVER TOLD: DVD (Order Number: FFBT0011) DVD 1965

GROWING IN FAITH (*series name*) Each video opens with a story which illustrates the elements of the sacrament as effective in normal living. Gaynell Cronin and Fr. Rathschmidt discuss the theology and practical application of the sacraments as the audience views people acting in the power of the sacrament. Questions for discussion allow for stopping the video and interacting with a group. Although sacraments are grouped according to type, each one is presented separately. Can be used independently within the context of an interactive lesson.

MASS FOR YOUNG CHILDREN (*series name*) The parts of the Mass to which young children can relate are witnessed, described and related to the children's experiences in their families. Although the tone and vocabulary serve young children, the images and voices of

#06) EUCHARIST: CELEBRATE UNION WITH JESUS & EACH OTHER (Order Number: CVCX0232) VHS Puppetry. 30 Min. 1988. Sr. Jane explores the concept of celebration: its elements, and what really happens when we celebrate. All these elements are presented within the Eucharistic liturgy.

SACRED HEART KID'S CLUB: SERIES III (*series name*) Children like to belong. In this unique Catholic Club children belong to the Heart of Jesus. This program incorporates a video series, resource manuals, and music cassettes. Sr. Jane is the facilitator of each episode. Each lesson begins with song, followed by the life situations of children, portrayed through puppetry or animation.

#27) EUCHARIST: GATHERED AS ONE AT THE TABLE OF THE LORD (Order Number: CVCX0273) VHS Puppetry. 30 Min. 1990. Sr. Jane shows different kinds of breads to Mimie. Today's meeting will be about the meaning of bread in our lives. Jeremy likes to eat in front of the TV but soon prefers to eat at the table.

STEWARDSHIP: A 3-D WAY OF LIFE MONEY BACK GUARANTEE (*series name*) USCC offers insight to stewardship programs within the parishes.

NOT FOR ADULTS ONLY (Order Number: CLXX0177) VHS Documentary. 25 Min. 1996. Introducing stewardship must begin early in the lives of Catholics. Distinguishing stewardship as the giving of time and talent rather than merely fundraising, young members discover God's gifts. Presentations on the revitalization of the Eucharistic Liturgy for youth, social ministries, and curriculum development for children are shared by parish leaders and youth. Personal testimonies give credence to the process.

SUNDAY MASS SERIES (*series name*) Parts of the liturgy are taped as they are celebrated at an actual Sunday liturgy in several different parishes. The celebration is interspersed by ordinary people and ministers commenting about what the liturgy means in their lives. Inspires to excellence in liturgical celebration.

LIFT UP YOUR HEARTS (Order Number: LLWX0024) VHS Instructional. 30 Min. 1995. Witness how the community of St. Peter Church, Cleveland prepares the table and themselves for the Eucharist. Parishioners speak about the witnessing of the Lord's table in daily events, and express their testimony through gestures at the altar.

TABLE OF THE LORD (*series name*) This series allows children and parents in the last episode to relate the Eucharist with ordinary events. Via the use of animation, story, and instruction, a clearer view is established.

#01) CELEBRATING (Order Number: SREX0039) VHS Instructional. 17 Min. This episode explains how we celebrate with friends and family, how Jesus celebrated in His life and how Jesus invites us to celebrate in the Eucharist.

#02) GIVING (Order Number: SREX0040) VHS Instructional. 17 Min. How we give with family and friends, how Jesus gave in His life and how He continues to give us the gift of Himself in the Eucharist.

#03) EATING (Order Number: SREX0041) VHS Instructional. 17 Min. How we eat with family and friends, meals were important to Jesus in His life and how we become one with Jesus by eating the meal of the Eucharist.

#04) PARENT PREPARATION (Order Number: SREX0042) VHS Instructional. 17 Min. This episode is directed toward parents of first communicants. Fr. Jack Rathschmidt, OFM Cap, joins Gaynell in giving parents a clear idea of what the children are being taught about the Eucharist.

TEEN'S GUIDE TO LIVING THE MASS (Order Number: LLWX0056) VHS Reflection. 45 Min. 1994. Youth choose to worship as Catholics. This video focuses on one parish's mission to welcome teens to

their own liturgy. Youth share feelings about Mass, good and bad. Hospitality, music and relevant messages are essential elements for the Eucharist to come alive.

THIS SACRED (*series name*)

EUCHARIST: IT'S ABOUT CHRIST DVD all three Sacred tapes on one DVD (Order Number: SRRX0024) DVD Reflection. 69 Min. 2000. Meal: Ellen is a catechumen trying to understand the faith commitment. A conversation with RCIA members leads to a discussion on the Eucharist. The sacraments take form in their daily experience and lives. People: Eddie invited Ellen to consider joining the Catholic Faith. Reminiscing on Eddie's life, Ellen shares her disillusion after Christian initiation with Eddie's wife Dorothy. Both share their journeys of dying moments and rebirth. Place: A young woman and an elderly musician meet after the funeral for her uncle. Through the intertwining of life stories and liturgical explanations, the sacredness of the church is revealed. Ed's simple but profound reflections touch a responsive chord in the young woman and epiphany as well.

MEAL: EUCHARIST IN OUR LIVES (Order Number: SRRX0016) VHS Reflection. 21 Min. 2000. Ellen is a catechumen trying to understand the faith commitment. A conversation with RCIA members leads to a discussion on the Eucharist. The sacraments take form in their daily experience and lives.

TO BRING THE GOOD NEWS (*series name*) VIDEO (Order Number: CLXX0182) VHS Instructional. 120 Min. 1992. This six session program is designed for flexible use in the process of forming committed faith filled teachers for Catholic schools. Each session incorporates prayer, a 20 minute video lecture in which a Catholic school leader or teacher presents an explanation of one of the themes, questions for reflection, time for sharing personal reflection and a concluding Eucharist liturgy or communion service.

TRAINING EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS (Order Number: LLTX0026) VHS Instructional. 42 Min. 1987. A comprehensive training program designed to explore the attitudes and hone the skills of Eucharistic ministers as they participate in this sacred service. 1) CELEBRATING THE MYSTERY OF FAITH (25 min) 2) "AS IT WAS IN THE BEGINNING" (28 min) 3) EUCHARISTIC MINISTERS IN ACTION (29 min)

TRAINING THE EUCHARISTIC MINISTER (Order Number: LLTX0021) VHS Instructional. 24 Min. 1987. The series is directed towards the training of liturgical ministers. The clear and concise presentations are beneficial to persons entering these ministries. These special ministers can not only hear but also see what their role is in liturgy and how they can best perform it. Both new and veteran Eucharistic ministers will benefit from this basic instructional program.

TRAINING THE MASS SERVER (Order Number: LLTX0023) VHS Instructional. 41 Min. 1987. Mass servers perform an essential ministry to God and God's people. A clear, concise, well-organized training program geared especially to them, based on the best-selling booklet, The Ministry of Servers, duties for the Eucharistic celebration. PART I) Explains how to prepare. PART II) Directions for serving during the Liturgy of the Word. PART III) Serving during the Liturgy of the Eucharist explains objects and terms they encounter and reinforces the value of this ministry and encourages young people to serve with willing hearts and minds.

UNDERSTANDING THE MASS (Order Number: LLWX0033) VHS Instructional. 55 Min. 1986. This 3 part video to be used with RCIA candidates, returning Catholics, High School classes, parish liturgy committees and adult education groups. PART 1 (15 Min) - Introduces the Mass, explaining why Catholics worship in this manner. PART 2 (15 Min) - Examines the Liturgy of the Word, including the Entrance Rite. PART 3 (25 Min) - Liturgy of the Eucharist, details the response of the community to God's word in union with the risen Christ.

UNDERSTANDING THE MASS FOR CHILDREN (Order Number: LLWX0034) VHS Reflection. 50 Min. 1988. Children learn what happens at Mass and why. Humorous and poignant scenes from the life of children show them that the Eucharist is not a reality apart from life, but a living part of their experience. Learn about Jesus of Nazareth and how the love he gave to people 2000 years ago is still given to us today.

WALK THROUGH THE MASS WITH BISHOP WUERL (Order Number: LLWX0084) VHS Instructional. 54 Min. Bishop Donald W. Wuerl wants everyone to appreciate the sacred and ancient mystery more fully, so he goes through the Mass step by step and show what is done and explains why. He examines in great detail the liturgical sights, sounds, the altar, vessels, furnishings and vestments. Broken down into four 10-15 min. segments: 1) Origins 2) Signs and Symbols 3) Liturgy of the Word 4) Liturgy of the Eucharist. 5) 3 Min. Mass and Christian life.

WALKS WITH JESUS (*series name*) This series provides concise meditative testimonies concerning the sacraments. Each enhances the tranquility of nature as the background for the reflective message.

VOLUME 1: EUCHARIST: MEDITATIONS FOR QUIET MOMENTS (Order Number: SRGX0017) VHS

Reflection. 21 Min. 1998. Link uses the power of video to convey new meaning and insight to the sacraments. The stories of Skeeter, Granny Hale and a Eucharistic Minister where Link underscores this faith: the celebration of the Eucharist is of central importance in the life of the Church.

WATER AND HUNGER (Order Number: PJGX0054) VHS Documentary. 24 Min. Three short vignettes show what the lack of clean water means for the world's poor, reveals the conditions and causes of poverty and discusses the realities of hunger, poverty and sickness. This threefold documentary won the Silver Award, for the International Film and TV Festival of New York. Through multiple visual images, song, music and voice-over commentary all the senses except smell are brought to an understanding of social issues surrounding water and hunger. These three segments not only provide the background information for accurate social analysis, the segment on water could also provide a reflection on water for Eucharist.

WE ARE SENT: EUCHARIST AND OUR LIVING AMEN (Order Number: LLWX0083) DVD Reflection. 18 Min. 2005. Fr. Stephen Adrian shares his St. Matthew parish in St. Paul and Minneapolis as we explore how the liturgy of the Eucharist sends us forth to live in the world. In five movements: gathering, listening to God's word, offering the gifts, blessing and breaking bread then sharing the meal and sending us forth, we hear everyday people share their own stories of Eucharist and mission. Ideal for small groups, adult or youth faith formation, intergenerational learning, RCIA and liturgical education.

WHAT CATHOLICS BELIEVE ABOUT (*series name*) Updated sacrament series hosted by Fr. Jeff Vomund or Fr. Mitch Doyen, and follows the same format as the original series with basic introductory questions with true/false or multiple choice answers. The correct answer presented in an understanding and concise presentation by Fr. Joe Classen or Fr. Matthew Bonk, C.Ss.R.

EUCHARIST - DVD (Order Number: SREX0094) DVD Interactive. 30 Min. 2005. Topics include: What do we mean Eucharist; When did Christ institute the first Eucharist; What were the words Jesus used; This is My Body-what does it mean; after what remains; Jesus accomplished the change by; Name for changing of Bread and Wine; We call all of the Eucharist because; how old to receive Eucharist; Who can receive it; can the Eucharist be withheld from someone; which is not a way to partake Eucharist; Other forms of worshiping Jesus; how often can you receive Eucharist.

Through scenes of family life, pictures representing scripture stories, commentary on what Eucharist means to use, recommendation of scripture stories to be shared with children, teaching parents how to respond to questions children may ask, stressing the importance of sharing bread with others, family prayer rituals which celebrate and affirm the child preparing for first Eucharist, suggests ways that normal and natural family activities lend themselves to preparation for first Eucharist.

WHAT IS SACRAMENT (Order Number: SRGX0088) DVD Instructional. 60 Min. 1986. Fr. Richard McBrien hosts three 20 min. workshops on the meaning of sacrament. Segment 1) a) Principles of Sacrament: sacrament as part of sacramentality. General principles and stressing the binding of God and humans, and humans to their church. b) Church's importance on the Universal level and Christian level and our seven signs instilled by Christ. c) Sacraments as acts of Church d) Purpose to unify church e) signs of faith, causes of grace. Segment 2) Sacraments of Initiation: process of initiation and connection/unity of Baptism, Confirmation and Eucharist. a) of the three sacraments: relationship to one another b) whole rite of Christian Initiation c) understanding the relationship, life

and Commitment; stresses the reconciliation to God and community.

WHAT THE EUCHARIST REALLY MEANS (Order Number: SREX0028) VHS Instructional. 20 Min. 1992. This video explains the parts of the Mass that teens relate to more personally. It is followed with topic development segment. Responding to typical questions (Why must we go to Mass? Why is Mass so boring? Why can't we do it differently, so it is interesting? If I can feel close to God when I am alone, why do I have to go to Mass?), it gives plausible reasons for our catholic worship patterns and explains the Eucharist in such a way that leads young people to accept the significance of the Eucharist for their own lives. Part one: History of the Eucharist also available.

WHY DO WE GO TO MASS ON SUNDAY -also on DVD MASS FOR CHILDREN (Order Number: LLWX0055) VHS Reflection. 13 Min. 2000. To a degree, students go through the motions of putting on a play production. The lack of commitment leads to a cancellation. The same can be applied to our preparation for the Eucharistic Liturgy, an event never cancelled.

WHY WE GO TO MASS (Order Number: LLTX0032) VHS 87 Min. A 2002 Fr. J. Glenn Murray, SJ, provides a provocative view of the Catholic Mass. This video is divided into three parts: 1) Liturgy and Our Lives. Murray shares personal experiences of making sense of liturgy for daily life. 2) Table Fellowship. Ritual reminds us of our rich heritage and how liturgy recalls our story. 3) The Mass. Murray presents a walk through the Mass so that viewers have a better understanding.

WITH BURNING HEARTS (Order Number: SREX0043) VHS Reflection. 25 Min. 1995. Spiritual writer Henri Nouwen presents practical application of a "Eucharistic life" for persons on faith. The Eucharist is an intensely human event, revealing the extremes of human emotions. Nouwen's approach is inviting to the contemporary Catholics.
