In 1632, a plague overwhelmed Oberammergau to the point that every family eventually lost someone to death. The town vowed to put on a play depicting the passion and death of Jesus Christ every ten years if there would be no more deaths. The town survived, and still to this day they offer the most famous passion play in the world every ten years.

The play lasts about five hours, with a meal break in the middle. Only people who were born in Oberammergau or who lived there for over 20 years can be cast members. The play will be offered 102 times between May and October.

Included in this pilgrimage will be stops in Munich, Prague, Vienna, Melk and Salzburg. We will celebrate Mass each day and visit some amazing places on our journey with Jesus to Calvary.

I invite you to join me on this journey to deepen your faith. Spots are limited due to tickets for the Passion Play. They expect 750,000 people to see the Passion Play in 2022. This promises to be an amazing pilgrimage in which you will meet wonderful new friends, deepen your faith, and be inspired to carry your cross more willingly side-by-side with our Lord.



Oberammergau & Central Europe 2022 Passion Play

DAY 1 DEPART CHICAGO O'HARE, ORD - July 9, 2022

DAY 2 ARRIVAL IN MUNICH - July 10, 2022

Meet your tour manager and driver upon arrival at Munich airport. Check-in to your hotel before heading to the famous Munich Hofbrauhaus for your welcome dinner. Overnight. (D)

DAY 3 MUNICH I PRAGUE - July 11, 2022

An orientation tour of Bavaria's capital features, of course, the Marienplatz in the historic heart of the city. Later, head for the Czech border in the Bohemian Forest and travel to Prague, the Golden City. Check-in to the hotel. Dinner at the hotel and overnight. (B,D)

DAY 4 PRAGUE - July 12, 2022

Your morning sightseeing tour reveals why Prague is considered as one of Europe's most attractive capitals. See 1,000 year old Hradcany Castle, the Old town, the Jewish quarter, and the Astronomical clock. Dinner at the hotel. (B,D)

DAY 5 PRAGUE I VIENNA - July 13, 2022

Morning departure for Austria's capital: Vienna! Known not only as one of the most beautiful cities in the world but also as the capital of classical music. Your orientation tour features St. Stephen's Cathedral, a view from the outside of the Opera, a drive along Ring Boulevard, and a stop at the Hofburg Palace. Check in and dinner at the hotel. (B,D)

DAY 6 VIENNA - July 14, 2022

This morning visit the famous Schonbrunn Castle, which was once the summer residence of the Habsburg family and home of Maria Theresa. Remainder of the day is at leisure. Dinner at the hotel and Strauss concert in the evening. (B,D)

DAY 7 VIENNA I MELK I SALZBURG - July 15, 2022

What a scenic day! Enjoy a leisurely Danube cruise to the most baroque abbey in Melk before you continue to Salzburg by driving through the picturesque Lake District area, which is not only of great beauty but was also backdrop of the famous film "The Sound of Music"! Remainder of the day is at leisure. Dinner and overnight. (B,D)

DAY 8 SALZBURG - July 16, 2022

Morning visit to Mozart's hometown. See the picturesque Old Town, the Mirabel Gardens, and the birth house of the city's most famous composer: Mozart! Afternoon is at leisure. (B,D)

DAY 9 SALZBURG I OBERAMMERGAU - July 17, 2022

Morning transfer to Oberammergau and some time on your own before it's time for the highlight of your vacation: **The Passion Play in Oberammergau!** Held every 10 years and performed by the Community of Oberammergau. Passion dinner and Drink Package is included. Overnight in the area of Oberammergau. (B,D)

DAY 10 OBERAMMERGAU I MUNICH TO USA - July 18, 2022

Transfer from Oberammergau to Munich airport according to your flight schedule. (B)
